Section 1 – Purpose

This Agreement sets forth the terms under which the parties intend to engage in the transaction or relationship described herein. Both parties acknowledge and agree that this document represents a legally binding contract enforceable under the laws of Canada.

Section 2 – Representations and Warranties

Each party represents and warrants to the other that it has full authority to enter into this Agreement, that it is duly organized and validly existing under applicable laws, and that entry into this Agreement does not violate any other agreement or law.

Section 3 – Obligations of the Parties

Each party agrees to perform its obligations as specified herein in a timely, diligent, and professional manner consistent with applicable Canadian laws and regulations.

Section 4 – Payment

Payment obligations shall be fulfilled promptly according to the method and schedule set forth. Unless otherwise stated, all payments shall be made in Canadian dollars.

Section 5 – Confidentiality

The parties agree to keep all non-public information exchanged under this Agreement confidential and to use such information solely for the purposes contemplated herein.

Section 6 – Term and Termination

This Agreement remains in effect until the completion of the agreed upon obligations or until terminated by mutual written consent or for cause in accordance with applicable law.

Section 7 – Liability and Indemnification

Each party shall be liable for its own actions and omissions and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other party from any claims arising out of breach of this Agreement, except to the extent caused by the other party's gross negligence or willful misconduct.

Section 8 – Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from or relating to this Agreement shall be resolved first by negotiation in good faith, failing which the parties agree to submit to mediation or arbitration in Canada.

Section 9 – Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Canada and the applicable provincial laws without regard to conflict of law principles.

Section 10 – Notices

All notices required or permitted hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed given upon delivery when delivered by hand, courier, registered mail, or electronic means with confirmation.

Section 11 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties with respect to the subject matter and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements, whether written or oral.

Section 12 – Amendments

Any amendment or modification to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both parties.

Section 13 – Severability

If any provision hereof is held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall remain valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Section 14 – Waiver

No waiver of any breach or default shall be deemed a waiver of any preceding or subsequent breach or default.

Section 15 – Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

Section 16 – Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for any failure or delay in performance due to causes beyond its reasonable control, including acts of God, government actions, or labor disputes.

Section 17 – Compliance with Laws

Both parties agree to comply with all applicable Canadian laws, regulations, and ordinances in connection with their performance under this Agreement.

Section 18 – Privacy and Data Protection

Each party agrees to handle personal information in compliance with applicable Canadian privacy laws and to implement reasonable security measures.

Section 19 – Independent Contractors

The parties acknowledge that they are independent contractors and that this Agreement does not create a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship.

Section 20 – Signatures
