1. Purpose

This Agreement sets out the terms of child support between Parent 1 and Parent 2 in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario, Canada, including but not limited to the Child Support Guidelines established under the Divorce Act and Family Law Act.

2. Child Support Amount

Parent 2 agrees to pay child support to Parent 1 in the amount of \$_____ per month for the support of the children named above. This amount has been calculated in accordance with the Child Support Guidelines applicable in Ontario and is subject to change by law.

3. Payment Method and Schedule

Child support payments will be made monthly by Parent 2 to Parent 1 via [specify payment method], due on or before the _____ day of each month. Payments will continue until the child(ren) reach the age of majority or as otherwise provided by law.

4. Special or Extraordinary Expenses

Parent 2 agrees to pay their proportionate share of special or extraordinary expenses for the children, including but not limited to childcare expenses, medical and dental insurance premiums, health-related costs not covered by insurance, educational expenses (including post-secondary), and extraordinary extracurricular activities, in accordance with Ontario law and the Child Support Guidelines.

5. Duration of Support

Child support payments shall continue until each child reaches the age of majority (18 years) or completes full-time post-secondary education, whichever is later, or as otherwise determined by applicable law. Obligations may be extended in case of incapacity or other lawful conditions.

6. Review and Variation

Either party may request a review or variation of this Agreement under the Family Law Act or Divorce Act if there is a significant change in circumstances affecting the child support amount. Both parties agree to negotiate in good faith and may seek mediation or judicial intervention if necessary.

7. Tax Implications

Both parties acknowledge that child support payments are not taxable income to the recipient nor tax-deductible to the payor, in accordance with Canadian tax law.

8. Legal Compliance

This Agreement is intended to be legally binding and enforceable under the laws of Ontario and Canada. Both parties have had the opportunity to seek independent legal advice and enter into this Agreement voluntarily.

9. Dispute Resolution

Should any disputes arise in relation to this Agreement, the parties agree to first attempt resolution through mediation before seeking any judicial remedies.

10. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties with respect to child support and supersedes any prior agreements or arrangements, written or oral.

11. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

12. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein. The parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Ontario.
