1. Appointment and Authority

6. Confidentiality

The Executor agrees to keep all non-public information regarding the Estate confidential, except as required by law or as necessary to perform duties related to the administration of the Estate.

7. Governing Law

This Executor Release Form shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province or territory of Canada where the Estate is being administered, without regard to conflicts of law principles.

8. Severability
