RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Parties intend to enter into a lawful marriage pursuant to the laws of Canada, and wish to establish their respective rights and responsibilities regarding each other's income and property and the income and property that may be acquired, either separately or together, during the marriage; AND WHEREAS, the Parties seek to ensure that this Agreement is legally enforceable and complies with the applicable provincial and federal laws governing matrimonial property and marital rights.

AGREEMENT TERMS:

1. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this Agreement, the following terms shall have the meanings set forth herein, unless the context otherwise requires: "Separate Property" means all property owned by either Party before the marriage and any property acquired by gift or inheritance during the marriage. "Marital Property" means all property acquired jointly during the marriage, except as otherwise provided in this Agreement.

2. PROPERTY OWNERSHIP

Each Party shall retain sole ownership of his or her Separate Property. Except as otherwise agreed, all property acquired jointly or in the name of both Parties during the marriage shall be deemed Marital Property and subject to equal division upon dissolution of the marriage.

3. DEBTS AND LIABILITIES

Each Party shall be responsible for his or her Separate Debts incurred before and during the marriage. Joint debts and liabilities incurred during the marriage shall be equally shared by the Parties.

4. SPOUSAL SUPPORT

The Parties agree that spousal support in the event of separation or divorce shall be determined in accordance with applicable Canadian law, taking into account the circumstances of each Party at that time. This Agreement does not waive any rights to spousal support unless expressly stated herein.

5. DISCLOSURE

Each Party represents that he or she has made a full and fair disclosure of all assets, liabilities, and financial information to the other Party before entering into this Agreement.

6. WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Except as expressly provided herein, each Party waives any right to claim an interest in the Separate Property of the other Party.

7. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province in Canada where the Parties reside at the time of execution.

8. ENFORCEABILITY

If any provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

9. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be amended only by a written instrument signed by both Parties.

10. INDEPENDENT LEGAL ADVICE

Each Party acknowledges that he or she has had the opportunity to seek independent legal advice with respect to this Agreement prior to execution.

11. EXECUTION

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts and shall become effective when signed by both Parties.

12. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This document contains the entire agreement between the Parties concerning the subject matter hereof.

13. DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

The Parties consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of their personal information solely for the purpose of negotiating and enforcing this Agreement, consistent with Canadian privacy laws.

14. SEVERABILITY

If any court determines any provision of this Agreement to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

15. WAIVER

No waiver of any breach of this Agreement shall be deemed a waiver of any subsequent breach.

16. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Agreement shall become effective upon the date of signing by both Parties.

17. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall be resolved by mediation or arbitration in accordance with the laws of the Province of residence.

18. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

Each Party represents and warrants that he or she enters into this Agreement voluntarily, free from duress or undue influence.

19. NO RELIANCE

Each Party acknowledges that he or she is not relying on any representation or statement not expressly set forth herein.

20. SIGNATURES

The Parties have executed this Agreement as their free act and deed as of the date written below.
