Agreement Terms:

This SPERM DONOR AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made between the Donor and the Recipient as identified above. This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which the Donor agrees to provide sperm for use by the Recipient for reproductive purposes. The parties agree as follows:

1. Donor Obligations

The Donor agrees to provide sperm samples in accordance with the requirements of the Recipient or fertility clinic. The Donor confirms that he is in good health and has disclosed any relevant medical or genetic history. The Donor agrees to undergo medical screening and testing as required under Canadian standards and applicable laws.

2. Recipient Rights

The Recipient shall have the sole right to use the donated sperm for reproductive purposes. The Recipient acknowledges that the Donor has no parental rights or obligations with respect to any child conceived through the use of the donated sperm.

3. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to keep confidential all personal information and details relating to the donation process, subject to legal requirements. Any disclosure of identifying information shall only occur with the prior written consent of the parties.

4. Legal Status of Donor

Under Canadian law, the Donor shall have no legal obligation or responsibility for any child conceived as a result of the donation. The Donor waives all parental rights and responsibilities, and the Recipient shall be recognized as the sole legal parent(s).

5. Medical Testing and Health Information

The Donor agrees to provide accurate medical history and to undergo all necessary health and genetic testing prior to

donation. The Recipient acknowledges that medical testing cannot guarantee the absence of hereditary or communicable diseases.

6. Consent and Voluntary Participation

The Donor confirms that he is participating voluntarily and has not been coerced or compensated beyond reasonable expenses. The Recipient acknowledges that this Agreement does not grant any rights beyond those expressly stated herein.

7. Indemnification

The Recipient agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Donor from any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from the use of the donated sperm or resulting children, except for claims arising from the Donor's own gross negligence or willful misconduct.

8. Term and Termination

This Agreement shall remain in effect indefinitely unless terminated in writing by mutual consent of the parties. Termination shall not affect rights or obligations accrued prior to termination.

9. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Canada and the applicable province or territory. Any disputes arising hereunder shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in the province or territory where the Recipient resides.

10. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties relating to the subject matter herein and supersedes all prior agreements, oral or written. No modifications shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties.

11. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

12. No Assignments

Neither party may assign or transfer their rights or obligations under this Agreement without prior written consent of the other party.

13. Disclosures

The Donor agrees to disclose any material changes to medical or personal information that may affect the suitability of the donation.

14. Use of Medical Facilities

The parties acknowledge that any medical procedures related to the donation or assisted reproduction shall be conducted by licensed medical professionals and facilities compliant with Canadian healthcare regulations.

15. Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of the right to enforce such provision in the future.

16. Signatures and Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

17. Records and Access

Medical records and donation information shall be maintained in accordance with applicable privacy laws and made available to the Recipient and authorized health professionals as permitted by law.

18. No Financial Gain

The Donor acknowledges that except for reimbursement of reasonable expenses, no financial gain or compensation shall be received for the sperm donation.

19. Acknowledgement

Both parties acknowledge that they have read, understood, and voluntarily accept the terms of this Agreement.

20. Contact Information Updates

Each party agrees to notify the other in writing of any changes to contact information relevant to this Agreement.
